'Home and Away' is a body of work that developed during a three-month camping trip travelling along the original Savannah Way track. The drive from Cairns to Broome has been described as the 'ultimate unique self-drive adventure' and is 3,700 km long, linking 15 national parks. The roads were often corrugated gravel but the amazing scenery and beautiful national parks we visited more than made up for that. We felt like pioneers in the wilderness, discovering waterfalls, gorges and wildflowers – a miraculous and spell-binding journey.

While I have documented my trips in journals since 1998, this is the first time my daily ritual of painting and writing has been exhibited in public, necessitating a more realistic approach to the landscape than I have done in the past.
