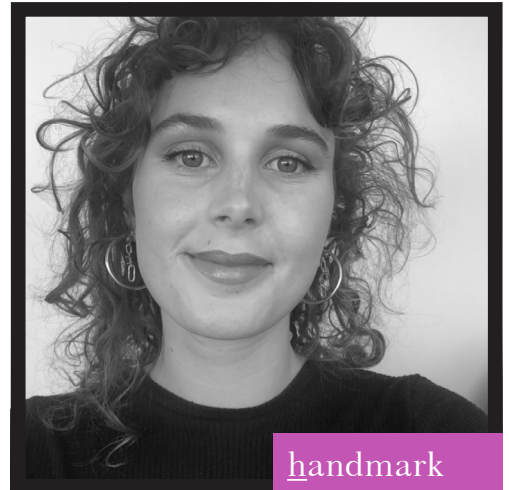


chloe catto —

Through processes of iteration and layering, fragmented non-spaces filled with ambiguous figures blur together with degrees of transparency and density, as forms, shapes, and figures emerge and retreat within the pictorial space. These works seek to evoke the duality of living in an urban setting that is entangled with nature while exploring how place becomes a condition of things that arrive. I used the notion of liminality to refer to the in-between and transitioning state of my surroundings.

I am an emerging artist based in Nipaluna/Hobart. I completed my Bachelor of Fine Art at the University of Tasmania in 2023 and am currently an Honours candidate. My practice embraces a multidisciplinary approach, working with ceramics, sculpture, and printmaking.

Informed by the process of three-dimensional collage, my work serves as a conceptual mode of relocation, re-contextualizing fragments of imagery and handmade/found objects into different spaces that are layered with time, place, and people.
