## emily snadden — eucalyptus collection



Inspired by iconic, threatened eucalypts, this new collection considers the delicate silvery foliage of Eucaluptus perriniana (Spinning Gum) and the Tasmanian floral emblem, Eucalyptus globulous subsp. globulous (Tasmanian Blue Gum).

For these works I have focused on the soft foliage of these two beautiful species, the silvery grey leaves of the spinning gum alongside the elegant curled blue gum leaves. Some leaves are imperfect, some are infected with gall.

With juvenile foliage and mature leaves, gum nuts and twisting branches, handmade and hand engraved in sterling silver and solid gold alongside native Australian sapphires scattered throughout. Elegant, statement jewellery pieces with a serious undertone – a consideration for the impact we have upon the environment and the part we all play in its conservation.
